The coaching staff will handle any questionable calls on the field during a game, or any other incidents during a game, not the parents or relatives of our players. This includes any violation of rules for any league or tournament we play in.

The A's Organization is known as a class act and we expect all coaches, players and parents to abide by our Code of Conduct policy. Anyone who violates this policy will be spoken to, with a warning of the violation of this policy and/or be asked to leave the organization with no refund issued as a result of the violation of this policy.
